Duties and Responsibilities:

The Mechanical Design Engineer will provide product design, engineering, document control, testing, analysis and sustaining services.

Product Design and Engineering includes: Concept generation, hand sketching, SolidWorks 3D CAD modeling of parts, assemblies and creation of drawings, supplier resourcing and technical research, testing and evaluation of prototypes and finished products, fabrication and assembly of models, prototypes, test fixtures and hardware.

Certain aspects of new product systems will require more in-depth analysis in the form of kinetic simulation, finite element analysis, and thermal modeling. These tasks will be completed to the best of your abilities and it is expected that a significant amount of learning may be required on the job.

Document Control and Sustaining Engineering will include maintenance of the PDM Pro vault, adherence to quality systems guidelines and protocols, and detailed revision and configuration management for products developed by the company.
